

Travel by train or bus





From world-class pistes and ski yoga on the mountain, to Austria's first children's ski link: The ski mountains of the Schladming-Dachstein Region are full of surprises.
























For the ski stars of tomorrow. And late bloomers.


What is an absolute must for anyone visiting Schladming-Dachstein?

Even though Schladming-Dachstein lies in the heart of Austria, Nordic sports also look back on an extensive tradition here – especially in Ramsau am Dachstein. With 220 km of beautifully maintained trails for classic as well as "skating" techniques, this former venue of the 1999 Nordic Ski World Championships has long been a magnet for holidaymakers and top-flight athletes alike – in fact, if you're out on the cross-country trails, it's not unusual to be overtaken by members of the international Nordic skiing elite.
